These exams are in a specific subject area and should be taken at the end of the year the student enrolled in the specific course. **Only the most competitive colleges require achievement tests for admissions and placement. Check appropriate college catalogs/web sites, the Guidance Department website, and consult with your teacher and counselor regarding registration for these exams.**

#### SCHOOL CODES:

We recommend both the ACT and SAT's. Students have the option of selecting which SAT and ACT scores they wish to submit to colleges. Juniors should not have scores sent to colleges at this time. The test results arrive approximately six weeks after each test administration. **In addition, it is highly recommended that students register for these exams as early as possible in order to ensure a seat at Brentwood High School as your testing site. Registration is open for the entire 2016-2017 school year at this time.**

The search is fun and effective although somewhat commercial. **NOTE**: Please beware of high cost financial aid services. They use the same database.
