The DANTE Foundation of Nassau County, Inc. is a nonprofit organization founded to foster Halo-American heritage and culture through education and philanthropic endeavors. We are awarding several \$5,000 scholarships to graduating high school students of Halo-American ancestry who reside in Nassau or Suffolk County and who will be attending an accredited college or university. Finalists will be invited for a personal interview with our selection committee and winners will be announced in May 2019.

We are seeking students who have achieved high standards in the academics, participated in extra curricular activities and scored above-average on the SAT/ACT exams. Financial need and other personal factors will also be considered in the holistic review of the applicants. We will accept a maximum of four applications from each school. Please give applications to only four students. Any additional applications will not be considered.

The four students you recommend are to be submitted by you under one cover:

- 1) Personal information
- 2) Copy of transcript
- 3) Copy of SAT/ACT scores
- 4) Essay (as listed in Item #12)
- 5) Three letters of recommendation

STUDENT SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

TO ALL STUDENTS:

The DANTE Foundation of Nassau County, Inc. was founded December 19, 1984. The organization is composed of 100 men and women of Italian heritage, who have united to encourage fellowship among all Americans of Italian descent; to renew the traditions of the Italian heritage; to generate funds; to establish scholarships for outstanding youths of Italian ancestry and to support deserving charitable organizations and causes.

We are awarding several \$5,000 scholarships to graduating high school students of Halo-American heritage who reside in Nassau or Suffolk County and who will be attending an accredited college or university. Our committee will hold personal interviews with finalists and announce winners in May 2019.

Qualifications For All DANTE Scholarship Awards:

At least one of your parents must be of Italian descent. You must have a successful academic and extra curricular record, and above average SAT scores. When applying, all responses must be typed. Hand written responses will be disqualified. Responses must be submitted in packet form - under ONE COVER FROM YOUR SCHOOL. RETURN YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION TO STAFF MEMBER WHO GAVE IT TO YOU.

1. Answer questions 1 through 12.
2. Attach a copy of your transcript.
3. Include a copy of your SAT Scores.
4. Submit three letters of recommendation.
(example: Counselor, Teacher, Clergy, Coach, etc.).

***The last day our office will accept mailed packets is February 28, 2019. Incomplete and/or late packets will automatically be disqualified. No extensions or exceptions will be granted. For confirmation of our receiving your packet, include a self-addressed stamped postcard. Cards without postage will not be returned.

APPLICATIONS SHOULD NOT BE SENT BY YOU.
GIVE YOUR COMPLETED PACKET TO THE SCHOOL STAFF MEMBER FROM WHOM YOU RECEIVED THE APPLICATION. ONLY FOUR APPLICATIONS WILL BE ACCEPTED FROM EACH SCHOOL.

5. What a DANTE Scholarship would mean to you.

You should incorporate any other information about yourself, and/or your family, which you feel, would be of interest to our selection committee.
