

CRITERIA FOR MID-ISLAND CLUB
SCHOLARSHIP AWARDS

Each applicant must meet the following criteria in order to be considered for the Mid-Island Club Scholarship Awards.

1. Applicant (male or female) must be of African American heritage
2. Applicant must have minimum cumulative average of 85%
3. Applicant must attend a Suffolk County school.
4. Applicant must have submitted applications for admission to colleges/universities.
5. Applicant must submit a Mid-Island Scholarship Award application, an official transcript (which includes first quarter senior grades) and two letters of recommendations: one must be from his/her guidance counselor.
6. Applicant must be available for a personal interview with the scholarship committee.
7. Applicant must submit a 250-word essay about themselves and why they believe they are deserving of the scholarship.

*Mid-Island club also is presenting an incentive award for a promising college-bound student who may not meet the minimum 85% cumulative average but excels in other areas. For example: leadership, entrepreneurship, technology and service.
