In an effort to help further the education of our local high-school seniors, Suffolk Federal in partnership with Suffolk County Community College is now offering local high-school seniors a chance to win scholarships for college. Scholarships are administered under the auspices of the Suffolk Community College Foundation, Inc. Below are the different scholarships available to Suffolk County's college-bound high school seniors attending college for the first time:

- 1) Suffolk Federal Scholarship
 Award: \$5,000 (1 award, \$2,500 in the Fall and \$2,500 in the Spring) - 4 Scholarships available
 - Recipient must be a member of Suffolk Federal at the time of the award.
 - Minimum High School GPA of 77
 - Demonstrated involvement in extracurricular activity and/or community service.
 - Student must be a resident of Suffolk County.
 - Student must submit an essay of no more than 250 words explaining their eligibility and how they will benefit from receiving this scholarship.

- 2) Navy SEAL LT Michael P. Murphy Memorial Scholarship
 Award: \$10,000 (1 \$5,000 award, 2019-20 academic year; and 1 \$5,000, 2020-21 academic year)- One Scholarship Available
 - Recipient must be a member of Suffolk Federal at the time of the award.
 - Minimum High School GPA of 77
 - Demonstrated involvement in a school sport or extracurricular activity or involvement at a community-based organization.
 - Student must be a resident of Suffolk County.

- 3) The Michael E Reilly Foundation Memorial Scholarship for Excellence in Fire Science and Emergency Medical Technology
 Award: \$5,000 (1 award, \$2,500 in the Fall and \$2,500 in the Spring) - One Scholarship Available
 - Recipient must be a member of Suffolk Federal at the time of the award.
 - Must be a volunteer of Suffolk County Fire Department, volunteer of local EMS or be enrolled in a Fire Protection Technology or EMT Paramedic program at SCCC in the Fall 2019.
 - Student must be a resident of Suffolk County.
 - Student must submit an essay of no more than 250 words explaining their eligibility and how they will benefit from receiving this scholarship.
